

## **The Steam Apprentice Club**

The Club was formed in 1979 for young people under the age of 21 who are interested in Steam on the Road, by the National Traction Engine Club. Today it is the young person's branch of the National Traction Engine Trust, a registered educational charity.

Many people see engines at rallies, but few of them know how an engine works, and even fewer have the chance to be shown over one by the owner, to talk about the work it used to do, or even to help with the engine's maintenance.

It is the Club's aim to educate our members about road steam, it's operation, history, use and maintenance.

The Club has a quarterly magazine, Raising Steam, with many of the articles being written by Club members.

We have a scheme which allows Club members into a large number of Steam Rallies free of charge. If required, we will try and put you in touch with an engine owner near you, so that you can learn more about engines from people who actually run them.

We also run Driving Days around the country, to get you on the footplate, driving under the careful supervision of the owners. In addition you are able to go onto the NTET driver course from the age of 13, where proper instruction is available from the experts, both technical and practical.



The Steam Apprentice Club runs a log book scheme, where you can record your progress as an Apprentice. After you have completed all areas of the log book, both practical and technical, and are eligible for a provisional drivers licence, you can progress to the Voluntary Certificate of Competency test.



The Club also has many competitions through the year for all ages that you can enter. Our Magazine has an area for club members to advertise to each other.
